Blouse Yr 10,11	White tailored, v-necked revered collar, short/long sleeves
Summer Shirt	White, polo, embroidered with school crest
Tie Yr 7,8,9	Striped blue
Tie Yr 10,11	Blue with motif [optional]
Socks	Black or white

Jumper	Plain black, v-necked, long sleeved jumper

UNIFORM POLICY

Uniform is considered important at Highfield Humanities College and all students should conform to published requirements.

The Pupil Welfare Officer may be contacted if we feel that a pupil may benefit from, or be entitled to, a uniform grant from Blackpool Council.

In exceptional circumstances, a pupil who is not able to wear full school uniform **MUST**:

- have a very good reason for it, which must be supported by a written note from home
- hand the written note from home to the House Tutor, who will decide if an 'exceptional case' note can be issued, FOR ONE DAY ONLY.

Exceptional circumstances that need to be applied for longer than one day must be referred to the Head of House.

If, however, a pupil does not have a good reason and a written note from home, he/she will be offered a change of clothing to correct the uniform, or given a letter to take home describing the problem. The letter must be signed and returned by 8.30a.m. the next day and the uniform problem must have been addressed by then. Pupils who persist in failing to comply with uniform requirements will be sent home.
